

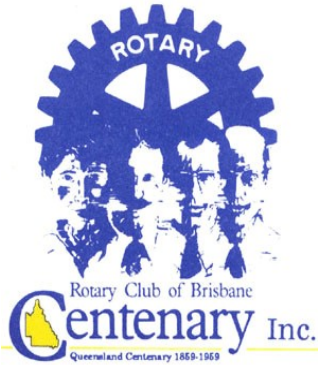

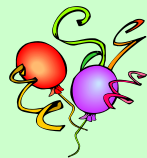
World's Most Accurate Pie Chart
